- Incorporate media, games, and study space.

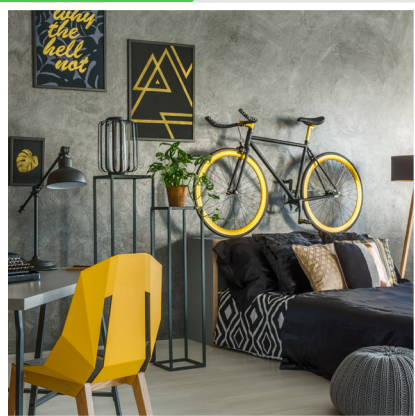

- Repurpose rooms for hobbies or relaxation.

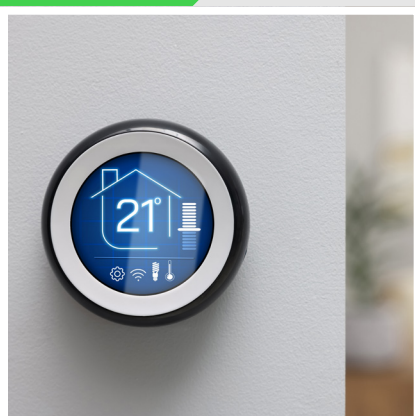
