A cohesive aesthetic brings harmony to every home,

### PLAN FOR FAMILIAR FLOW

Design spatial rhythm that feels instinctive, room to  
room, home to home.



- Position kitchen islands and appliances in locations consistent for cooking flow across homes
- Orient seating or even soaking tubs toward skyline, ocean, or mountain views
- Echo creative ceiling treatments (tray, vaulted, or flat) to frame each interior
- Replicate bedroom layouts: same locations for electrical needs, same closet approach
- Plan entry sequences that mirror each other: foyer, art wall, then great room

### CARRY THROUGH A SIGNATURE PALETTE

Unify your aesthetic with materials that reflect both  
personal taste and local flavor.

- City penthouse: high-gloss walnut, dramatically veined marble, bronze inlays
- Coastal escape: whitewashed driftwood, bleached linen, patinated brass
- Mountain retreat: distressed pine, saddle leather, hand-forged iron
- Recur elements across homes: arched mirrors, sculptural vases, plush seating
- Use balanced color and material palettes as a signature, warm neutrals or deep cools

#### CITY LOFT



- Tailored urban edge with warmth
- Floor plan focused on skyline views
- High-gloss walnut + dramatically veined stone
- Repeated sculptural lighting and contemporary accents

#### COASTAL RETREAT

- Relaxed refinement by the water
- Breezy layout embracing ocean vistas
- Driftwood tones + natural organic fibers and textures
- Shared curved sofa, unlacquered brass hardware



#### MOUNTAIN LODGE



- Elevated comfort with rustic depth
- Views framed by distressed oak beams
- Saddle leather, wool, and matte black finishes
- Consistent art placement + antique layers
