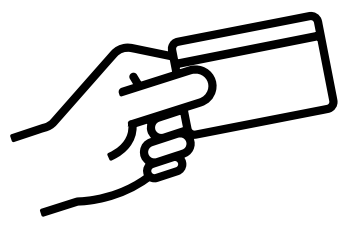




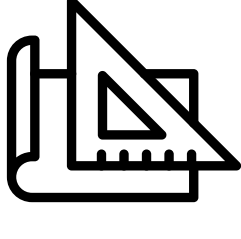

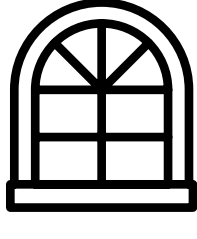
Empty Nesters Are Investing More

typical homeowners.

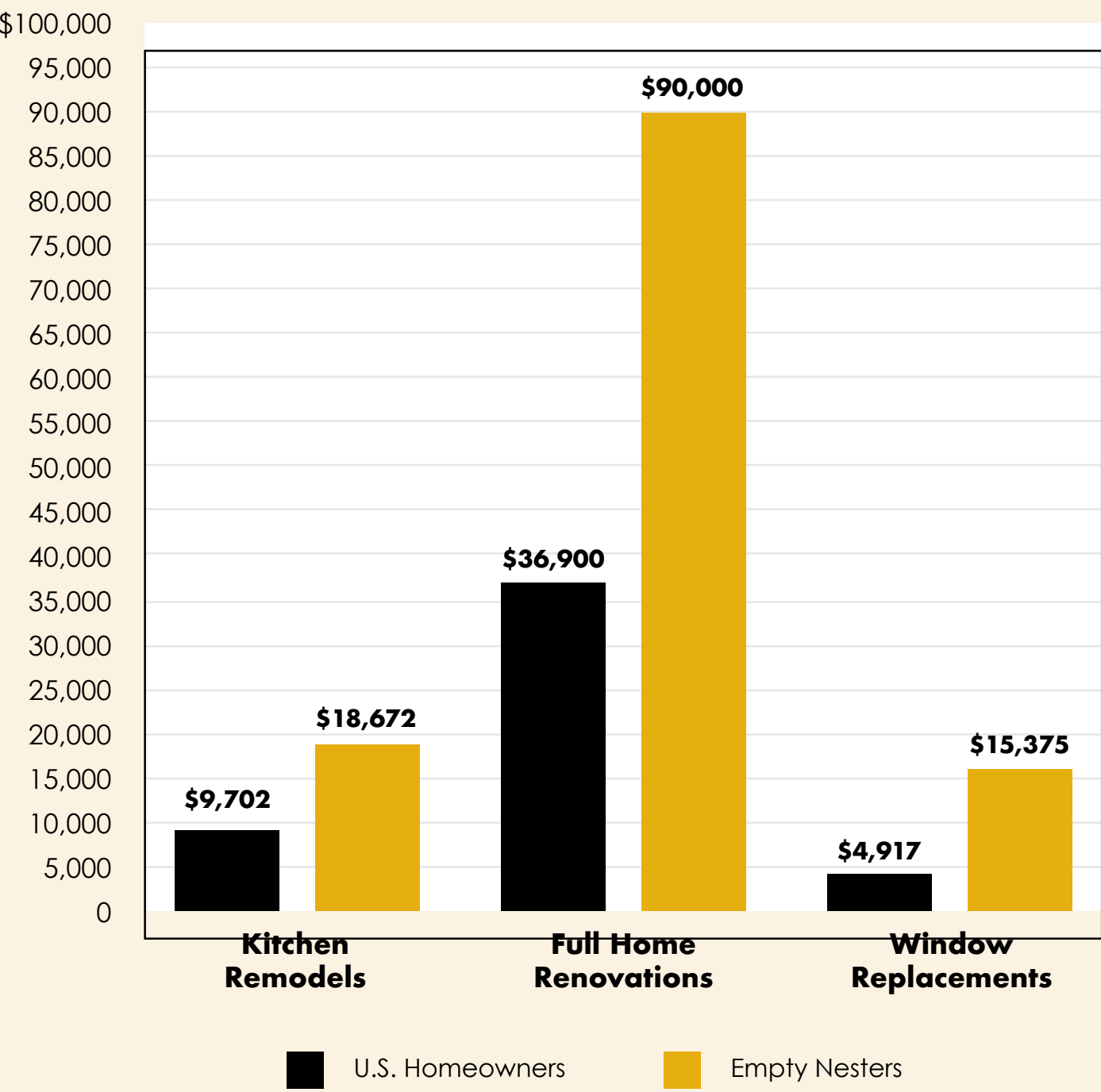

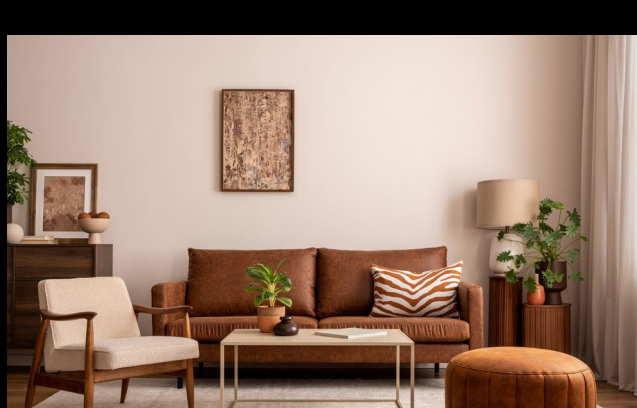
