



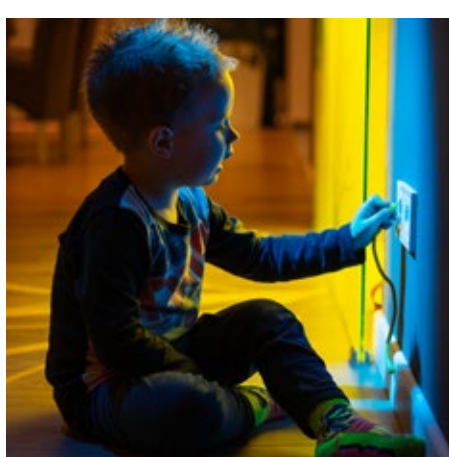

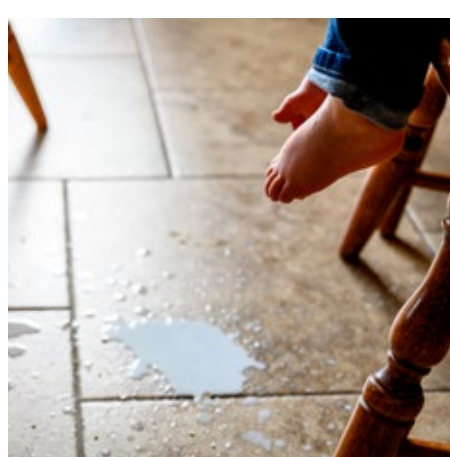
SPOT THE TROUBLE ZONES

Unsecured Outlets



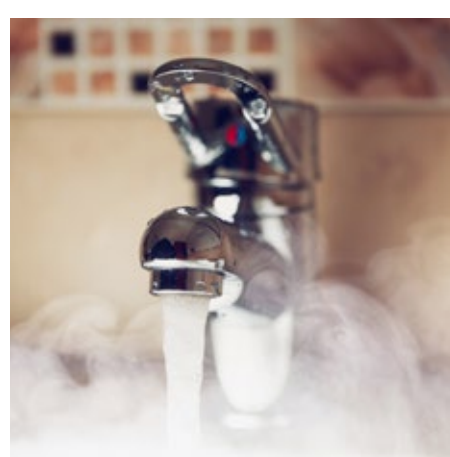
Tiny fingers plus live plugs equals danger

Snap-in covers keep fingers safe



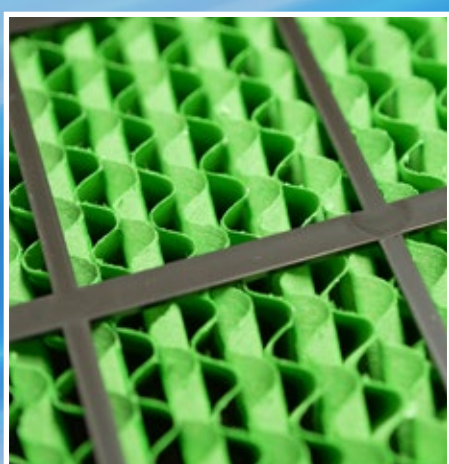
Hallway Lighting

Plug-in nightlights reduce nighttime stumbles.

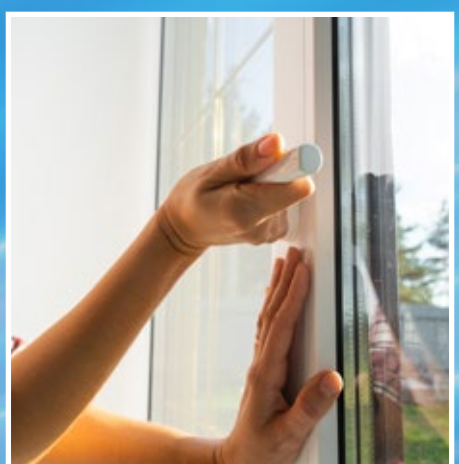


DON'T FORGET COMFORT Air Matters Too!

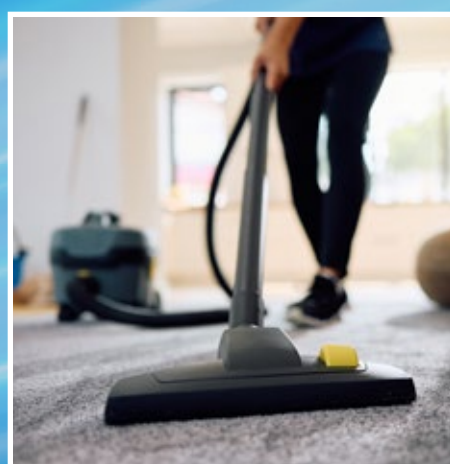
Kids with allergies are extra sensitive to dust, mold, and dander that often linger in older homes.



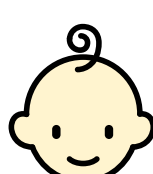
Make sure to use HEPA air furnace filters

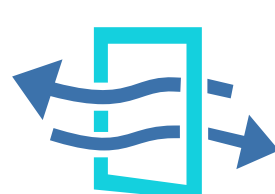
